11 And that, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep: for now is our salvation nearer than when we believed. 12 The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of light. Romans 13:11-12

Laying aside the distractions of life and taking an honest view of what is happening around us will bring the conclusion that the world is in desperate need. In South Africa, people are faced with corruption at all levels of government, the consequences of which are rampant crime, lack of basic needs, and a hopeless view of the future. Every continent of the world is faced with the same problems, bringing the resultant loss of optimism at what the future may hold. In the USA, school shootings, suicides, floods and storms, corruption, drugs, alcoholism and an endless list of that which follows a godless society are reported every day by the news media. Having arrived in the US just a little over two weeks ago, Lucinda and I see a country that is falling; imploding for lack of God's Word. Pride, idolatry, self-centeredness, materialism, and spiritual adultery among the people of God have opened the door for the destruction of this land in which they are living. When will God's people awake? Is it too late? What must God do to bring this country to it's knees before Him? The symptoms of this implosion have been stripped bare for the world to see, but the cause is being neglected. If God's people fail to realize the cause of these symptoms, there will be little opportunity to prevent the judgment that comes on any people that reject God. As Paul admonished the Christians in first century Rome, so he admonishes us today. It is high time to awake out of sleep! Sleep? We need a good reliable van – We will be traveling from Missouri to Nebraska to Ohio to Georgia from 2 April until the 27th of June. This past Sunday evening we visited with one of our supporting churches and the pastor suggested that we rent a van and divide the cost so that any of our supporting churches that would like to help cover one week of rental could do so. He said their church would take the first week. We thought this was a good idea and found that we can rent a van for \$2800 for 12 weeks. Since his church will pay for the first week, would you be willing to help us for one of the other weeks? This translates into about \$235 per week.
