On September 11th we had our first day of Language School at the YMCA. Things moved very quickly and we are amazed at how far the class has come in just two months. We still have a long way to go but we are grateful for all the Japanese we have been able to learn.

I was asked to come and do a children program at a church not too far from where we live. After the children's program I was to preach the afternoon service. I was very grateful for the opportunity. She has been living in Japan for many years now. She said that before today she thought all she needed in life was to believe God existed. After the message on prayer, she understood a little more about having a relationship with Jesus Christ. Praise God! Pray that she will soon receive Christ as her Savior.
