Proverbs 17:6 - "Children's children [are] the crown of old men; and the glory of children [are] their fathers". In September, our youngest daughter, Christina, gave birth to our fourth grandchild. His name is Henri. He weighed in at 8lbs 8oz. Christina and the baby are doing well (the dad Enrique also "survived"). We are very excited and blessed.



In ministry, we are crowned with His provision, protection, and opportunities to be used of Him. We presented our ministry in a church in Kingsport, TN, where we had a wonderful time with the Pastor, his wife, and the good people of that church. We look forward to their participation in our ministry. Another

meeting we had scheduled was cancelled, but we were able to participate in a missions conference in another church in Johnson City, TN, in October. There were elements of that conference that were very moving. A young Nigerian man in the church expressed that God spoke to him through the messages about not just giving out a tract or inviting folks to church, but giving the gospel specifically.

We finished that conference on Sunday, the 7th; then on Monday the 8th, I boarded a plane and headed to Bolivia for our annual pastors conference there. It was a profitable week. There were five souls saved, and 33 folks surrendered their lives to Lord. Sixty pastors, missionaries, and national evangelists attended. Everybody present brought the evening service attendance to 350. The theme for the week was

"Servants with Integrity". There was a good spirit, and there were good responses in invitations. God's servants there expressed their appreciation and desire to repeat the conference next year. The Lord gave me the privilege of speaking 10 times. I was also able to preach in the church of a national Bolivian pastor named Velasquez. He shared with me his deep concerns



about the growing influences of false religions. He said that Islam, cults, and Pentecostal diversions are even drawing some "Baptist" church leaders into their ranks. Pray that God gives us wisdom how to help these national pastors.

As you get this letter, there will have been two more Fires of Evangelism conferences conducted the same week. One was in Bayshore, NY, and the other in Sabanagrande, HONDURAS. Lord willing, I will be going to our conference in Guatemala in November, and Nicaragua in December.

We would appreciate your prayers for Germán to whom I gave the gospel in Bolivia. He would not trust Christ, but was very warm and appreciative of my conversation with him. Thank you so very, very much for your investment in our lives and ministry. We are praying for you.
