Your Missionaries to the Philippines

Dear Pastor and Church Family,

The year of transition for Calvary Baptist Church is quickly coming to an end and we could not be more pleased with how Pastor Edgar and his wife Miriam are leading the church flock and Christian school. We feel extra blessed to see and experience this transition first hand; we know



that it is an added blessing and favor of God to us. Calvary Baptist Church celebrated 30 years of God's faithfulness last October 14th; it was a powerful, emotional, and humbling experience. Walking down memory lane of His amazing love to our family and this church was truly awesome! Evangelist Bob Jones from Clays Mill Baptist Church of Lexington, KY brought God's message challenging us to serve the LORD in a greater capacity for more years to come. We will strive to keep soul-winning, discipleship, church planting, sending out preachers, supporting more missionaries, and prayer in the forefront of all our ministries. The LORD Jesus brought us hitherto and will deliver us to the next leg of the journey (1Chron 17:16).

Fruits for Your Labor: November will mark 21 years that we have served in San Jose del Monte. Lately, Michelle and I have spent much time reflecting on the pure joy that bearing fruit brings. Our hearts swell with love and pride at the thought that those young people who have literally grown up under this ministry are now the leaders and key players in the work of the ministry. The couples who now lead our young



people were all young people here themselves. We have 6 graduates of our Christian school who are now teaching and becoming amazing leaders in our school. Those small children who used to be taught in Jr. Church are now the ones teaching. It is truly one of the greatest rewards of being in the ministry. May we never doubt the need and good that is produced through the nursery, Jr. Church, jeepney routs, VBS, feeding ministries, Bible Clubs, School ministry, camp and Youth Group! The Fruit of Church Planting: Apawan Village Church. We are currently the only gospel witness in the village as well as the neighboring village of Catahan in Loma de Gato, Marilao, Bulacan, 7 kms from Calvary Baptist Church. About 2,000 souls are at stake and we intend to reach them for the LORD Jesus Christ. An additional 10,000 people live within a 3 km radius. We currently have an average of 20 adults and 30 children coming every Sunday. Please pray that we will be able to purchase the land for this new church within the next year, only \$20,000 is needed. Hope Baptist Church: We are hoping for this church to be established by the beginning of 2019. Please pray that the building will be completed in a timely, cost-efficient manner.

Sowing in Tears, Reaping in Joy: In July, baby Isabel, who came to us in January of 2017, went to live with her forever family. Tears flowed in the church service that was dedicated to the transfer of parental rights from Bahay Sibol to the Castillo family. We again witnessed firsthand how adoption vividly portrays the spiritual adoption we have in Christ (Romans 8:15-17; James 1:27). We currently have 19 children in our home and look forward to uniting more children to the families that God has specifically prepared for them. We are in real need of full-time workers for this ministry; house parents, teachers believe etc. If we
