### Update on the Building of Hope!

As you already know, we had designed a **seven hundred piece puzzle** in the shape of Mongolia. This puzzle is being used to help **raise the necessary funds** to purchase the building and property we call **“The Building of HOPE.”**

For a donation of one thousand dollars you can have your name engraved on a puzzle piece and that piece attached to the puzzle in Mongolia.

This building will serve many purposes. One of these is the housing that will be made available for missionaries, medical missionaries, and church missions' groups. It will also serve as a place for Bible and Bible literature printing and distributing, as well as women's training centers and an underground Bible college.

As of the start of January we have **sixty pieces of the puzzle completed**. We need donations for **another ten pieces by the end of January**. This will give us the necessary funds to place a down payment on the building and property. This secures the building and makes us the only buyer.

This is a great blessing! A home for these ministries to grow and serve for many years to come. A shining light in a dark and forgotten country.

It is always a joy and blessing to see our children come together from all over the States to celebrate their love for each other. *“But let all those that put their trust in thee rejoice: let them ever shout for*

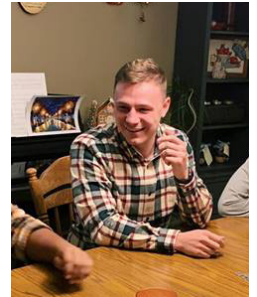


*joy, because thou defendest them: let them also that love thy name be joyful in thee.”*
