An Important Request:

We would like to ask you to keep Sandra's upcoming surgery in prayer. As you may recall, she is a 6 year cancer survivor. We celebrate that she has remained in good health on the cancer front. However, she has to have an additional surgery related to her original cancer procedure. This surgery is scheduled for November 26th. It is a major surgery and she will have about a 6-8 week recovery period after being in the hospital post-op for a week. We recently mentioned that the landlord of the property where our church, Iglesia Bautista Bíblica La Luz, is currently located said we need to relocate by March of 2019 rather than the Summer of 2021 which was the original agreement. What a punch in the stomach! However, where one door closes, another one often opens. This seems to be the case for our church!

Last August, we started a ministry across town in a new community where there is no church. Our partners in that ministry, the Arias family, have made some property they own in the area available to us rent free! They want to allow us to use it for a minimum of 5 years so a church can be established in the area. This family has a heart to reach people! There is a building in place with rooms that can be used for Sunday School and a kitchen. There are some details that we will need to take care of in order to prepare the rooms for church use, but they are relatively minor. The biggest challenge we have will be moving our portable building. We need to pour a foundation and a concrete pad in the new location in order to do so. There is also some finishing work that needs to be done to enhance it's appearance and functionality. Our plan is to use the next several months to make the location ready for when it is time to move!

The decision by the current landlord presents a financial challenge as the church has not had enough time to save money to make this move. But; God is bigger than the challenge! We are working on a budget but would invite you to contact us if you might be interested in helping the church take advantage of this tremendous blessing!

What moved our hearts the most is the attitude of our people. They see a new community without a church. They see a new school being built less than a block from the property and understand they can reach out to families as they move into the area. Indeed, this is an opportunity for the church to be a welcoming presence to people as they build their homes and establish their lives in a new place.

What an open door! What an answer to Prayer!
