Dear Friends & Partners;

In June, we received clearance from Sandra's doctors for her to travel internationally. Within 2 weeks, we were headed back to Bolivia and arrived before the end of the month. It is great to be back among our Bolivian brothers and sisters in Christ. We want to say thank to each one of you for your patience during our trip to the States and your prayers for Sandra as she was dealing with health concerns. Your faithful partnership has been a blessing and is greatly appreciated.

When we landed in Bolivia, there was a nice group of friends and church people at the airport to welcome us home. It was a blessing to see their faces and reunite with them once again. The church (Iglesia Bautista Biblica La Luz) is doing well and grew in our absence. We were blessed to see the faithfulness of our church members and to meet many new people. The church has many events and ministries planned in the coming months, and we will be telling you about them in future News/Prayer Letters.

As you may remember, we built our building in 2016 in a manner that it could be moved if the church ever needed to relocate. We are glad we did as the landlord canceled our lease 3 years earlier than expected, and we have been forced to move our entire building (minus the concrete floor of course) to a new location. We began this process in mid-June and have made great progress. The building is erected in the new location, the new concrete floor has been poured, and many of the finishing touches for the actual building itself are being done this week. We are also getting estimates to install bathrooms, tile, sidewalks, and classrooms. Due to various fees and cost over-runs, we still need to raise about \$3500 - \$5,000 to finish this project. One of the things we are most excited about is the groundwork that has been laid in a new community called Trigal over the last 2 years. We have had Bible Studies, Youth Meetings, Kid's Clubs, and special events in an effort to reach people with the Gospel. In the coming weeks, we will begin running a bus from this area to our main Church on Sunday mornings. In September, we will have a team from the US coming in to do evangelistic work in the area. It is our hope to see an actual church planted in this community in the near future.

Immigration and compliance with various requirements of the government is an important issue for most Missionaries. Upon our return, we had to work with Immigration regarding our visas and ended up having to make an unexpected trip to the US Embassy in La Paz, Bolivia to have some paperwork authenticated and submitted to the government. This was a costly trip that was very stressful and required a lot of patience. Hopefully, by next Spring we will have our actual permanent visas in hand. Please make this a matter of prayer.

As we noted above, there are more details that we will be rolling out in the coming months. In the meantime, please keep our family and ministry in your prayers as we do the same for you. We love you and are grateful for your interest in our lives and work. May the Lord continually bless you as you live for him;
