The only countries that still have any service to Mongolia are Turkey and Russia. Between these two countries there are only six flights a week. This is a great restriction on such a large country. Both Turkey and Russia are considering closing their borders to Mongolia by March first.

The results of all these closed borders is a country that is under extreme duress. Food is becoming scarce and what is available is at an inflated price. Getting medical attention is becoming very difficult. The doctors and hospitals are overwhelmed. The price of everything is rising fast trying to keep up with run away inflation.

As devastating as this virus is to the country of Mongolia, this is by far not the worst thing that is happening there. There is a drought in Mongolia. Not a drought for water but a drought for the Word of God!

All these side effects of the coronavirus are finite. They have an end. It may get even worse in Mongolia but at some point it will get better.

The drought of the Word of God deals with the eternal souls of the Mongolian people. The virus is temporary and deals only with the physical aspect of Mongolia. Psalms 120:1 says, "In my distress I cried unto the LORD, and he heard me." Our prayer is that at this critical low for the country of Mongolia we will have an opportunity to present an eternal solution.

Now is an important time in Mongolia to have God's Word available to these hurting people.
