REVELLINGS IN THE WORKING OF GOD

July & August, 2020

Though you and we are exhausted with the constant overflow of information and warnings concerning COVID-19, the veracity of the virus and its effects are obviously visible. It has also become personal for us. In the fall of 1990, Robin and I led Santiago Hernandez and his wife Marcela to Christ. They followed the Lord in baptism and spiritually grew over time. God called Santiago into the ministry. prepared, and God sent him to Tampacan, San Luis Potosi, Mexico; where he has pastored for a number of years. In June, he contracted the virus and died within three days. Two days

later, his son Natanael, who has been an evangelist to children throughout the country of Mexico, got the virus and died the next week. Natanael left behind not only a precious wife, Sandra, but also four young children.

Our society for years now has been sucking on the sap of identity politics. BUT DEATH does NOT defer nor deter according to identity. COVID has not either. We know of several faithful pastors who have been infected

and have succumbed to the virus' violence. Likewise, sin does not differentiate. But Hallelujah, our Savior DOES NOT either: "Whosoever will, may come!" "There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus." (Gal. 3:28)

As you know, we had our first virtual online conference in June. Incredible! There were over 100,000 different user connections during the week. Also, over 1.6 million hits were made on our

ministry webpage. I personally talked to a pastor in Bolivia whose heart God set on fire during this conference. He is excited and wants to see God bring great revival to Bolivia. His name is Jesus Miguel. We are looking and praying about doing two more virtual conferences: one with a focus on Central America in October, and one with a focus on South America in December. Otherwise, in-person conferences for the rest of the year have been postponed until 2021.

Meanwhile in Colombia the other Sunday morning, a missionary gave me

the opportunity, privilege, and blessing to preach via Zoom to a congregation from the suburb of Bogota, called Soacha. We had about 60-65 folks watching and listening. It was special to be a part of their services, being that they still cannot meet in person.

Our project "Multiply" is nearing completion. The text and content of the booklet has been proofed, corrected, proofed and approved. Today, I approved what they call the "dummy" (the paper, cover & size of booklet). Pray that God provides the final funding for this project (\$3000).
