MISSIONARY TRAINING & RECRUITMENT

At the BIO office we are preparing to host our Missionary Training School July 18-20. This year our theme is His Glory, Our Excellence. We are expecting more than a dozen missionaries to be present. We would appreciate your prayer support for the Lord to make this a profitable time of training, fellowship and edification.

At the end of summer and into the fall we are scheduled to minister at several Bible colleges. We are thankful for such opportunities which allow us to present what BIO has to offer, and we are able to connect with students who are considering their role in missionary service. Recently the Lord added some new missionaries to our ranks: a married couple who are in deaf ministry and a single brother going to Haiti.

MISSIONARY CHALLENGES
