This month has been difficult for us, but we have seen God work in wonderful ways!!. A young woman in our church informed us she was raped by a man who had visited our church. We took this very seriously We spoke with her and her parents, since they do not know sign language, and they wanted to report it to the police.

So we helped them do so. (Which was a very involved process.) Other Deaf people from the community have come against us, and have said they will make a case against us because the young man was put in jail but he is innocent.

They have bullied our friend Sonny, trying to make him afraid because he made a statement to the police, they have threatened us, and have worked to see this case dismissed and us punished instead. The father has even agreed to now drop the case, and told us the daughter changed her story. We do not know if that part is true.

What we do know is that by mercy and truth iniquity is purged (Prov. 16:6). We know this is spiritual warfare, as they are all from the former church, or had been previously discipled by me, but I parted ways because of doctrinal disagreements and continuing sin.

Praise God that today after court the man who was leading the charge against us sent me several messages asking for forgiveness. In humility he wrote and said how he had seen true Christian love from me. It is by God's grace and work this happened! We were determined to stand for truth, and to show the love of Christ, and He has given us victory! We are still praying for all involved, that God would have ultimate victory through the whole situation. Proverbs 16:7 "When a man's ways please the LORD, he maketh even his enemies to be at neace with him."
