Indonesia

After five flights through four countries we finally landed in Manado, Indonesia on the island of Sulawesi. Our first victory was to get all of the vitamins through customs that my nurse daughter

(Amber) brought for the kids at Faith Children's Home. After our missionaries, the Cunninghams, picked us up



at the airport we were soon being greeted by dozens of beautiful children.

We were so blessed to visit Faith Children's Home and to participate in the ordination of Pastor Berens. In addition to preaching the charge to the church on September 17, I was able to baptize nine of the children who had recently trusted the Lord Jesus for their salvation. I was doing

okay emotionally until I baptized a young boy named Glen Mohammed. The amazing love of God brought tragedy to this Muslim



boy's life so that he could be brought to a Baptist children's home and find Christ!

On our last night in Indonesia the Lord enabled

me to preach a simple, clear Gospel message to these children. There are still some who have not come to an understanding of



sin and salvation. After the message we had a sweet time of prayer, and then something that I have learned to loathe—saying goodbye! Amber, Jeremiah and I left part of our hearts here at Faith Baptist Children's home. Please pray for the Cunninghams, Pastor Berens, his dear wife, Jill, and for this home.

The Philippines

BIO Missionaries, Nap and Shirley Donado, picked us up from the airport and took us to Angeles City were we met up with two more BIO missionaries, Chris and Carol Woodley. For the last leg of our trip we split our time with the Donados and the Woodleys.

Nap and Shirley took us to one of their newer missions in Camaling where I was able to preach. Four young



ladies were saved that night in spite of barking dogs, chickens at my feet, and a torrential downpour.

The next day I was privileged to speak with Chris Woodley at a Men's Fellowship hosted by Nap's first church plant—The



Word Baptist Church. Several churches came together with over 80 men present. The Lord gave great liberty!

Sunday Morning was spent with Cornerstone Deaf Baptist Church. The Lord laid a message on my heart for this church. Carol Woodley confirmed



it by sharing with me some of their people's struggles. It was a blessed service with one young lady receiving Christ as her Savior!

Sunday night I preached at Beulah Land Baptist Church, and then Monday before heading to fly home, we visited with Cornerstone Baptist Deaf Academy. They gave us such a special presentation! There is so much more I wish I could share!
