Mosa will be remaining at Bible Baptist Church to help in the ministry during 2018.

At the graduation, we looked around at those attending the service. What a blessing to see nine of our graduates in attendance, and all nine in service for the Lord! After 22 years, we have seen the growth of men and women in whom God has placed the desire to serve the Lord. We remember the words of the

apostle John, "I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth." 2 John 1:4. We rejoice to see God raise up men and women who have been equipped to reach the Deaf with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.
