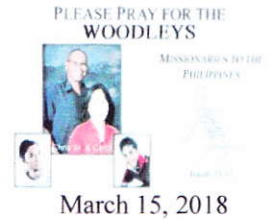

It is a blessing to witness these three young men equipped, enabled, and empowered to minister to the saints of Cornerstone Baptist Church in Mabalacat, Pampanga and Cornerstone Baptist Deaf Academy in Bamban, Tarlac. Please continue to pray for good health and travel mercies. We also ask that you continue to pray for our two sons, Christopher and Emmanuel. We appreciate your prayers and faithful support to our ministry in the Philippines. May the Lord abundantly bless you.
