We have been informed that the owner of this facility must sell the building, which we have been managing for the past eighteen months and that does create a big problem for us! Thankfully it is not too big for our mighty God!

The good news is this building, since day one, has paid its own staff, taxes, utilities etc. This is a rare find on the mission field. Thus allowing the operational funds for this ministry to be generated on the field! The goal for this building is to equip the national churches with tools for the advancement of the Gospel, rather than setting up a ministry that can only thrive with the presence of outside funds.

We are currently in the process of raising the needed funds for this property, but we need your help to make this




The Calvary Is Coming!

Update on the Printing Press


God is good to us and the printing press is busy. Over the past few months we have been working hard printing Sunday school materials.
