I'd like to begin this letter by saying a **HUGE** "thank you" to many people. It has been quite evident that we have had a lot of people praying regarding my health problems which began 7 months ago. Also, we have had some churches help us financially with medical costs. We are very appreciative of your help.

We have never had difficulty with health issues so my stroke was new territory for us to traverse. I'd say that the word I would use to describe it would be "frustrating!" Over all though, God has given us more of a burden for those that are suffering with their own health concerns. I have met many others and have tried to be an encouragement and witness to them. In our absence, one of our main church family folk in Australia just had hip replacement surgery last week. This is making us miss our ministry so much more.

Before we left Australia, all public schools were transitioning to a new program called "Safe Schools." From Kindergarten through the 12th grade, schools were being made to teach the homosexual and transgender ideology. The government was trying its hardest to get rid of the Religious Education program and replace it with this godlessness. We were consistently picked on for 2 years and had many reports generated by child safety to discredit our work with the 1-3 grades and 5-6 grades, approx. 300 students each week. The legislation is now written and is ready to be placed into the law. Our rights as educators and as a church will be attacked even more. If the government hears any speech against this law, we have been promised that it will be met with fines, court, and imprisonment. We desperately need prayer to block this new change. There are not very many people in government that are standing up to this travesty. As a totally socialist country, we are not allowed to voice our concerns. Sadly, we see the United States moving in the same direction.

Please continue to pray for my recovery. Sadly, my Doctor suspended my therapy over the last month. My greatest difficulty is being unsteady on my feet due to severe dizziness. This makes it very hard to walk or do therapy. I have been assured that this is a normal issue and will pass eventually. Praise be to God that I am out of my wheelchair and walker! God is hearing and answering many prayers for us.
