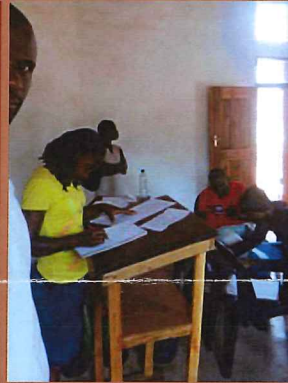
Missionaries to the Deaf of Zambia and Malawi

The Lord has taken care of the Deaf Chipata church ministry in some challenging situations. He is growing Paul in his leadership skills, and teaching him patience as he deals with people and problems. We are very thankful for Paul and his dedication to the Lord's ways and the ministry.

Paul and his wife Ethel had their third child in September. They named her Lorna after the faithful missionary who was like a mother to Paul. She is a beautiful baby!

We are grateful for the opportunities we've had to share the update on the ministry in several churches in Missouri, Tennessee, and New York. God has been so gracious to us with wonderful supporters, and we are grateful for all who pray for us and those in Zambia and Malawi.

Zambia is facing a very hard time right now, due to drought. The whole nation is having daily power outages from 14-17 hours. The country relies too heavily on hydro power, and when the rains are low, everyone suffers. Small business owners are losing money, as many of them have purchased freezers to sell meats and other frozen items, but cannot afford generators to sustain their business. Please pray for things to turn around soon. Prices have also increased for fuel, food, electricity...things are hard for many.

Nearly all the Deaf in Chipata are underemployed or unemployed. Recently Bro. Paul helped connect them with a Deaf Rights' Advocate, and he came to the church to help them sign up for better job opportunities, and give business owners more exposure to the needs of the Deaf. Please pray many would get jobs through these efforts.

Brother Paul's middle daughter has constant issues with her brain and development, and is being examined in Lusaka. She has been staying with her grandmother, and that has been very hard on all of them. Please pray for them to get answers soon, so they can see what she needs. Pray for funds as well to pay the doctors, especially if she requires therapy or surgery.

We have several opportunities to share in new churches in the coming months. Please pray we could raise some more support, as we are at about 77% at the moment.

Pray for our daughters as they continue to settle in here, and for their spiritual lives. Pray that God would draw them close to Himself, and they would feel and know His love.
