New Testament Baptist Church in Mirebalais, Haiti. Over 600 attended. That night four placed their trust in the Lord Jesus.

Following the first anniversary celebration Joel hosted the first annual preaching conference of the Church. He invited a few supporting pastors to participate in the conference. It was a great meeting, and several were saved.



On two occasions, following the evening service, we baptized in the river using flashlights and cell phones. As we walked back to the main road, I could easily see the Milky Way in the

night sky. I was reminded of the promise that God made Abraham in Genesis 5:15: "Look now toward heaven, and tell the stars, if thou be able to number them: and he said unto him, So shall thy seed be." What a privilege it was to witness a small part of God's promise to Abraham play out in Haiti!

The highlight of the trip for me was the time we had teaching a dozen Haitian pastors serving in Haiti



and in the Dominican Republic. I taught on missions. Following the conference two pastors from the Dominican expressed their gratitude for the teaching and said that they were going to go home and plant another church. Praise the Lord!
