

In addition to this blessing, our precious people were able to get some relief from the government. Each municipality distributed rice, canned goods, and ramen noodles to every household. Several of our members sent us messages praising the Lord for His provision. As we go through these present challenges, it is not easy to live worried and stressed. The circumstances may look frightening and overwhelming, but thanks be unto God, which always causes us to triumph in Christ. (II Cor. 2:14a) I read a statement by J. R. Miller that says, "Christ is building His kingdom with earth's broken things." Heaven is filling with earth's broken lives, and there is no bruised reed that Christ cannot take and restore to glorious blessedness and beauty.
