Most of my time is spent calling churches to book meetings. Being on the phone for 10 or more hours a day and making well over 1,000 calls a week is certainly not the funnest part of being a missionary, but it is all part of the process. God does bless our work though. I have some openings left this year, but I am also looking ahead to next year. We are more than 50% booked for next year. Our hope and plan is that we will have next year 100% booked by October. I will then be able to do more with my time, preparing myself for the ministry we will do in Honduras.

Thank you, as well, to those of you who have been praying for the health of Pastor Gardner. He has improved greatly. He is already back to preaching from the pulpit. Last Friday, he taught a great class on marriage to the missionaries and students of the Our Generation Training Center. We are looking forward to put what we learned into continual practice.

News from Honduras this month centers around the virus (no surprise). There have been over 1,000 deaths and over 39,000 infected with Covid-19 in Honduras. Pray for the country of Honduras as it goes through this time. Pray that people would be able to provide for their families.

It is encouraging to remember that God always takes care of His children. Let me share one recent example of that with you from my own life.

I had a meeting for last Sunday evening, but I was not able to find one for the morning. I called the pastor with whom I already had a meeting scheduled to let him know when we would be arriving. I asked him if we could plan on worshiping in their morning service as well. He was fine with that, but he took the time to call a friend and schedule a meeting for us with his church. God is a Father who loves to bless His children, and we know that just as He cares for us, He will care for those we are praying for, such as those in Honduras and you, our prayer partners.

We are thankful for each of you, and pray that God will bless and encourage you as we head into a new month.
