## Missions Trip

Acts 11:1-4 And the apostles and brethren that were in Judaea heard that the Gentiles had also received the word of God. 2 And when Peter was come up to Jerusalem, they that were of the circumcision contended with him, 3 Saying, Thou wentest in to men uncircumcised, and didst eat with them. 4 But Peter rehearsed the matter from the beginning, and expounded it by order unto them, saying,

The setting here was a dispute between Peter and the Hebrew saints, who were upset that Peter had mixed with the Gentiles (v. 3). They ignored the most important event – the Gentiles had received the word of God! Let's focus on the major things and minimize the lesser things! At any rate, Peter gave a report to the saints when he returned from his missions trip. I would like to do likewise for our missions trip this month to Michigan and Ohio.

Harvest Baptist Church of Grass Lake, MI, a supporting church, hosted Linda and me for a Sunday through Wednesday missions conference with two other missionary families. Once again, I had liberty to preach, and I believe the folks received us well. The following morning, we left for Georgia, and made it home the following day.
