Despite all of the bad news in 2020, we still were personally involved in the salvation of 83 precious souls in 2020, and that is 83 black eyes to old Smutty-face, the devil, even Lucifer. Beyond that, I would add all of the inmates and officers who heard the Gospel, and have not, as yet, received eternal life. Breaking fallow ground, planting, and watering are all victories in the eyes of the Lord. We cannot lose in the soul winning enterprise! And despite all of the fake news, the Truth is still being heralded, God is still in control of everything, we still have eternal life, and brothers and sisters in Christ with whom we can worship and fellowship. We have a Bible which cannot be destroyed or even dented or scratched. And we have both recovered from Covid; for us, it was little more than a bad cold which lasted for a week or so. I still haven't recovered taste or smell, and Linda had a nasty sinus problem. It left both of us with little "get up and go," but like I said – it could have been much worse. We are much better now.

And, praise the Lord! We have a three day revival meeting scheduled for January 20-22, 2021, in Sneads, FL, at ACI West. Please do pray that this meeting will proceed unhindered, and that Jesus will be exalted to His proper position by the preaching and witnessing.

We love and respect you all very much for caring for us during these difficult times, these times when we are hindered to conduct prison revival meetings. We look forward to the prisons opening up to us in 2021, when we can once again bring forth fruit to abound to your account. Have a wonderful New Year!
