## What is a **SMART CONFERENCE?**

A SMART conference is when a church provides our <u>daytime</u> training class to the missionaries who come to their conference. Usually it takes four hours per day for two days. NOTE: These daytime classes do not interfere with the conference in any way.

This is an efficient way for missionaries to access SMART modules because they do not have to travel to some distant location, at their own expense in order to get this valuable training. That is because the training actually comes to them; to where they already will be, i.e. your church's conference.

Your church can choose the module you'd like us to teach your missionary guests.
