We treasure the time we get to be near family, and we are also thankful for the family of Christ that we are a part of because it helps us feel at home everywhere we go. We rounded out the month with a trip to the Midwest, and had some great fellowship with believers there, and Andrew preached in each church.

We had several churches who had to cancel meetings this month and last due to Covid in the church, and while we understand that was necessary, we ask you to pray with us that the Lord allows us to keep a filled calendar in the months to come. Even though we trust God's timing, we long to be on the field and we are working hard towards that goal. Andrew is currently working on getting more meetings booked, and we look forward to finding out where God will take us next!
