Travels:

We thank God for his **protection** and believe that this is a result of many of your prayers on our behalf. Since our last letter we have traveled over **8,500 miles**, passing through **14 states.** God has permitted us not only to be in some wonderful churches presenting the work in Brazil, but we have also had the privilege of seeing some of the beauty of this great country.

Family:

We were blessed to have Stanley back from his internship for two weeks before leaving for his semester in England. We traveled out west for a conference in Colorado and made use of the trip to do a little family vacation and see some of the western part of the U.S. **Stanley** is very **happy with the experience** of being in a small college setting with good Bible classes as well as practice training and physical work, as this is **similar** to the way we will be developing the future **Bible college in Brazil.**

Kevin has just started his senior year and has quit his job to be able to dedicate himself to studies as well as help me with driving and preparing things for our return to Brazil. **Continue praying** that the Lord may make clear His will and **direction for Kevin's life.**

Return to Brazil:

As for now, we are preparing to buy tickets to return to Brazil the **second half of November**. We ask that you be praying for **Kevin's Passport renewal**. When we applied for the new passport we found out things are taking a long time to process, but that it "should" come before our departure. **Pray that it does.**

We also ask that you **pray** that the Lord would open doors for **Zirlene's citizenship interview** to happen before we go, so we don't have to come back next year just to do that. This would save time and money.

Projects:

We are often asked about projects on the field that need funding. There are many structural needs for the camp and we always rebuild, or expand, as the Lord supplies funds and therefore take one step at a time. The next project we are in need of since we finished the remodeling of the dorms, is the remodeling of the bathrooms. Each bathroom (boy's and girl's) will need to handle 150 campers, and comes at a cost of around \$7,500 each. We praise God for a church that has already donated for the girl's bathroom and we are praying that God may supply the remaining \$7,500 for the boy's Bathroom, as we hope to get these ready for February 2022 Family camp.
