GIVING HOPE TO THE HOPELESS IN THE PHILIPPINE ISLANDS

October 2021

To God Be The Glory

"Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it." (I Thessalonians 5:24) My God is faithful. He has given me my calling, *Giving Hope to the Hopeless* in the Philippines, and I know He will get me there. I have purchased my airline ticket to head to the Philippines. I contacted the Philippine Embassy, and as of right now, they are not permitting any foreigners to enter the Philippines. This means I cannot get a visa at this time. I have watched God begin to put everything in place for me to leave on March 1, 2022. I know He will open this last door in His perfect timing. He is faithful!

September was a busy month. The Lord gave me several meetings in East Tennessee. In between meetings I am sorting and packing boxes to send to the Philippines. I was having a hard time finding a Balikbayan shipping company (a Filipino shipping service with flat rates) near me. I found one that was based out of Indiana that comes down to Knoxville to retrieve boxes; however, I was having a hard time finding the exact box size needed (24x18x24). When all hope was running out, I prayed and googled one last time. I found a *Sari Sari* store and market (A Filipino convenience store) in Knoxville that had a shipping service also. I can go and purchase a couple of boxes for \$10 each. Each time I bring those boxes to the store to ship, they will give me the same number of boxes for free. **He is faithful!**

As I was sorting this past month, I came across my prayer letter from October 2020. I was only at 28% of my support at the time. I am so excited to announce that as of October 1, 2021 I am at 94% of my monthly support needed. I want to thank Grace Baptist Tabernacle and Emmanuel Baptist Church in Fort Scott, Kansas for partnering with me. They voted to take me on when I was with them. What a Blessing! I have a couple of other churches that will be letting me know at the beginning of January if they can partner with me. I know the rest of the support will come in. He is faithful!

My last few prayer letters, I have mentioned the money that is needed for my outfit and passage fund (This includes funds for an airline ticket, a possible two-week quarantine at a government sanctioned hotel, residential visa application fee, first and last month's rent with security deposit, and appliances.). The grand total was \$10,000. I am thankful to be able to announce that it has all been pledged. Thank you to each church and individual that has given and will be giving to this need. He is faithful!

Through the process of getting ready to leave for the Philippines, I have been in contact with the Ocampos. Our most recent conversation was about their preparation for my arrival. The Lord has blessed Heavenly Bible Baptist Church with a very nice, large piece of property. For the last 50+ days they have been building "The Hall." They are hoping to be able to finish the building soon but are running low on funds. To complete the building, it will cost \$10,000. Please pray that the Lord will supply this need for them. They are planning on starting a children's feeding ministry in this building in preparation for my coming. I am looking forward to helping in this ministry upon my arrival while I am learning the language and culture during my first term. We know God will supply the funds for this building. He is faithful!

Thank you for your faithful prayers and support. He is Faithful!

On August 29, 2021 after 257,000 miles (200,000 in six years) our 2012 Dodge Grand Caravan passed its last MILE MARKER; the transmission finally went out. It was going to cost us \$4,000 to have it repaired. We gave this need to the Lord, and He provided a

2019 Dodge Grand Caravan with 73,000 miles on it. We bought it from one of our



missionaries leaving for the field. Our home church helped us with a generous down payment toward this van. Two weeks ago I flew to Detroit, hugged and prayed with our missionaries as they left for Thailand, and drove the van home. The Lord is faithful!

Paul said, "Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before." (Philippians 3:13) Yet, it is good, from time to time, to look back at life's MILE MARKERS in order to rejoice and thank God for what He has done. King David agrees. He said, "I remember the days of old; I meditate on all thy works; on the work of thy hands." (Psalm 143:5) Many of you have partnered with us from the very first MILE MARKER. Let's rejoice and thank the Lord together.

MILE MARKER 1: On **July 14, 1991**, Roanoke Baptist Church realized the

call of God on my life and ordained me unto the Gospel Ministry. missionaries, passed away suddenly at 32 years of age. We traveled to Jacksonville, Florida for his homegoing service. Please pray for Paul's family.

In August we finished a busy summer schedule with helping a Missionary friend's cooperation with **Medical Missions Outreach** in the Hungarian speaking part of Transylvania. Brother Bradley Edmondson brought a team of US healthcare workers on this trip, and they proved to be a great blessing! The patients who came to the clinic received a **clear Gospel presentation** and at the conclusion the local missionary and **his team were invited to start new works in three different villages**. Due to our Hungarian language skills we were able to help folks at the reception and witness to them as they waited for examination or medicine.

On the **Prayer Request side**, I would like to mention that all of a sudden we lost communication with our **Syrian girl** for reasons unknown to us. We are concerned that her family basically decided to scare and shut her down. Please pray that the Lord would have His Way in the situation.

Also, **Hungarian Lawmakers** passed an amendment on September 26th on 'Prolonging the special legal order and special measures related to the coronavirus pandemic until Jan.1, 2022'. By the time when we are all tired of government-imposed restrictions, we just got a fresh reminder that it is not completely over yet. **Please pray** that we would not have to have again some strict lockdown mode as a country!

Thank you for praying for being allowed back to Prison! Your prayers were answered! Just as we finished our latest *Hungarian Bible video* for the Prison Ministry, we got word that we can go back to in person meetings from the 1st of October. It is such a breakthrough because the Prison System was on a lockdown since March of 2020!

As the local **media outlets touting away with the fourth wave** and delta variant scare, we are thankful that so far the Lord kept us safe and sound. Please pray that we stay healthy and prosperous in the ministry!
