I have had another cancer come into my life. I have two types of skin cancer and the doctors are in the process of removing them. My lower lip and face has been affected and the doctors were able to remove the cancer on my lower lip and I will have more surgery on my face to remove the other spot that has been affected. The Lord has given me grace to go through this and I am monitored by the staff of Michigan Medicine. We have known since November of the cancer, but the COVID-19 put a stop to some of my medical care. They have now begun to treat and I am able to see my doctors on a regular basis.

Our family is doing well. Josh our son is at West Coast Bible College and is finishing his second year. He has been lead by the Lord to go into evangelism. We are excited to see what the Lord has in store for him. He will be traveling this summer with Neighborhood Bible Time. Alyssa who is a senior will graduate this spring from high school and is going to get a medical degree in cardiology. She will be attending a local college as well as doing some online Bible courses. Matthew is finishing the 5th grade and is looking forward to summer break. Our daughter Jamie who is an early educational teacher will be getting married this summer. She has met a young man from the upper part of Michigan and they will be serving the Lord in a local church near their workplaces. Please be in prayer for our eldest daughter Amanda and her family. They are going through a rough patch and need some prayer and wisdom from our wonderful Lord. We have a lot going on this summer and are looking forward to all of the events that will take place. Life is extremely busy and the Lord is giving my wife and me the strength to watch our children grow up! It is truly a blessing!
