

Dear Co-Laborers,

Oct. 28th Amparito had her second cornea transplant in her right eye. We are extremely grateful for your prayers and our Lord's perfect provision during both corneal transplants. Amparito's vision is about 85-90% of what is expected after the full recovery period is complete. At this time, she has good distance vision and only needs reading glasses. She was previously very limited by her foggy vision but now she says she feels like a new person! We have just got back home to Bolivia the 9th of December and are in the process of getting everything settled.



Oct. 3rd just before our trip to the U.S. we were having Sunday morning services with the Mount Olives Baptist Church. Sister Nicanora tells me before the service started about a new family that was coming regularly to the church. The mother Nilsa Para. had requested to have her children dedicated to the Lord that morning. So at the end of the service I explained to the couple the significance of presenting our children to the Lord. I explained that presenting our children to the Lord without previously presenting our lives or receiving the Lord in our hearts was an empty religious formality. Nilsa's face began to glow as she said I have wanted to be saved for a long time! So that moment we prayed together as she gave her life to the Lord Jesus Christ. Then her children Elizandra age 9 and Elias age 2. were presented to our Lord. The husband is very open to the gospel and our prayers are for him to follow his wife and soon also become part of God's family. This family came from the city of Santa Cruz looking for work and a place to

live. They have basically nothing and are living under a tarp, with the children sleeping on the ground. Please pray for their spiritual and also their basic material needs.

December 19th we had the 32nd anniversary celebration in the Mount Olives Baptist Church. There were many visitors that had an opportunity to receive the Gospel this morning of joyful celebration of our God's faithfulness in the last 32 years.



Simultaneously the Tierras Nuevas Baptist Church had 11 young people baptized and the whole church stayed after for the monthly "Love Feast" fellowshiping and eating together in a sweet time of many blessing.



We are still meeting in person and on Zoom simultaneously. Recently there has been an uptick again in COVID cases in Bolivia. All we can do is to continue trusting in God's sovereign will in these chaotic times. We may soon have the privilege to participate in our Lord's second coming! We need to live in this reality that He could return at any minute! Our earnest prayers are that Bolivia will remain open to preach the Gospel in these time of great upheaval on every front.

Thank you once again for your prayers and faithfulness all these years.
