Thank you Prescott Baptist Church in Prescott, Kansas; Faith Baptist Church in Morristown, Tennessee; and to another individual. I am grateful for each church and individual that faithfully prays and supports me.

New Beginnings in the Travel Process — The Philippine is still very strict on who can come into the country due to COVID. My father and I have been trying to get information stateside; while BIO Philippines is working to get answers in the Philippines. Many of you have been so encouraging during this process and I appreciate it. God knows the future, and His timing is perfect. BIO Philippines is working on procuring an Entry Exemption Document. I am in need of this document in order to apply for a missionary visa. They have sent a petition (invitation) letter to the Philippine Immigration Office of Consular Affairs. This is the first step. New Beginnings with Family — I am a new auntie, again! I was so excited to be a part of my sister's delivery team on December 30th, 2021. She did an awesome job and is doing well. It would be such a blessing to see the auditorium full of friends, family, and fellow labors for Christ. Lord willing, I will be leaving for the Philippines on March 1st, 2022. Once I arrive in the Philippines I will have to quarantine for at least ten days. When I am cleared to travel, I will hit the ground running. I will begin my language studies and will help with the children's feeding program. Please begin praying now that the Lord will continue to open doors and prepare hearts to hear the Gospel.
