Dear Friends in Christ,

Thank you for your prayers for Seth since our last email. As reported in our previous regular email, Seth will be going to the US for consultations with the cardiothoracic department at Washington University/St Louis Children's Hospital. His appointment is on the 6th

of April. Currently, his mom and dad are preparing for their trip to the US. We will be coming back for a few months of furlough at the same time.

Seth has been doing well. However, the issue is the abnormally high pressure in the right ventricle of his heart. This excessive pressure will eventually cause heart failure. So, there is an urgency to get him to the US soon. We praise the Lord that God has been answering prayer concerning this trip. Today the US Consulate granted Jennifer's husband a visa to come to the US to be with Seth and Jennifer. We ask that you pray that God will continue to guide and provide.

This kind of move will be challenging for their family. Therefore, your prayers are greatly appreciated. Imagine selling everything you own here and coming to the US with the clothes on your back, literally! Brandon, Jennifer's husband, will not be able to work because of the restrictions on his visa. So, Jennifer will have to provide for their family during this time.

Seth has medical insurance here in South Africa. However, when he boards the plane, his insurance will not pay for any treatment in the US. Because of this, we have started a GiveSendGo page for him. Please share this with your friends. We are trusting the Lord to provide for the initial consultation and tests. Once the doctors set a course, we will know the future amount needed for his care.
