Dear Friends in Christ,

Seth and I recently had this conversation as I pretended to be a lonely boy, and he wanted to help me. He gave me a New Testament as our conversation grew more about how to be saved.

Me: "You mean sin is something I do that is bad?"

Seth: "Yes!"

Me: "But what if I don't want to go to Hell? What must I do?"

Seth: "Pray!"

Me: "What do I pray?"

Seth: "Lord Jesus, I want to go to Heaven. Please save me. In Jesus' name, Amen."

Me: "Oh, I ask Him to save me?"

Seth: "Yes! Then you will go up to Heaven when you die."

Me: "What about my sin?"

Seth: "Jesus died for our sins! That means the nails in His hands, the crown of thorns on His head,

and He died."

Me: "What happened when they buried Him?"

Seth: "He came back alive!"

Me: "So, Jesus is our Saviour?"

Seth: "Yes! Because He died for our sins."

Incredibly, little children can grasp the salvation message when adults stumble at such simple truths.
