Nicole and I had a great time participating in a missions conference in northeast Florida. During this pan-

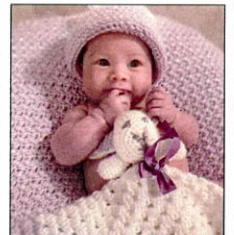
demie it is encouraging to see God's people abounding in hope.
