Our BIM! Exit Interview is done! We did it a little early as we were passing by the campus on our way to another conference. It is exciting to see that we are getting close to the end of deputation.

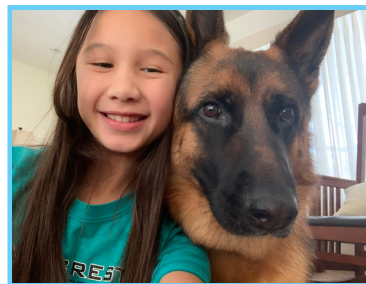
