What a joy to come together with dear Christian believers and missionaries as we returned to the country of Mongolia! Seeing the faithfulness among the Christians was so encouraging.

As many of you know we had finally received a window of opportunity to return to Mongolia in January. Once again we were reminded His ways are not always our ways! We had received word that our visa was no longer available. It is amazing how God has worked this situation to His good. After many months of managing the print shop through video call, we were ready to return to the people of Mongolia!

In Isaiah 45:2 it says, “I will go before thee, and make the crooked places straight:..” This verse has a special meaning to Kim and myself. After waiting, praying and working several years towards a secure building for the printing ministry, God has opened a great door for us. He has gone before us and proved once again that this is His ministry and not ours. Only God knows how many people will come to know Him through the work and printing of God’s Word in this building.

As of March 25th we have a building secured in our name for the printing ministry. God is so good!

I would ask you to please keep the Kruchkow family and this building in your prayers. Now that we have secured this building of hope there is much more to do. First item on that list is a boiler system for heating this building. We have been looking at the cost, availability and how quickly we can get this accomplished. Lord willing this work will start the first week of April.

Over the last six years we have been blessed to manage a building which also has housed the printing ministry. Our task now is to continue to manage the building that houses the printing ministry while preparing the Building of Hope to become the printing ministry’s permanent home.

Acts 12:24 says, “But the word of God grew and multiplied.” We pray that this verse will continue to apply to Mongolia. Please pray for the salvation of the Mongolian People!
