One man has been a long time attender, but realized he had never been saved himself. Since receiving the Lord, he has brought numerous visitors to church so they too can hear the gospel. Those men had never shown an interest in darkening the doorstep of church. Here is a new believer enlisting in the work Jesus has summoned us all to; proving one can reach many others.
