We have reached 70%!

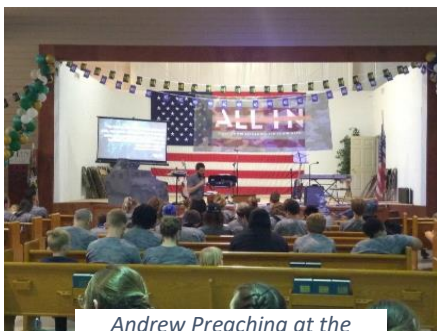

The end of deputation is in sight and, as always, we are looking forward to what God has in store for our family in Honduras.

In other news from this month, we had the wonderful privilege of visiting some missionary friends, the Blooms, who are church-planters in New York City, working in Chinese communities. **Would you pray for them as God does a wonderful work? Would you pray that many Chinese would receive Christ as their Savior? Would you pray that the Lord would do mighty works in the many church-needy cities throughout our country and the world?** We were reminded that the harvest truly is plentiful.
