Please continue to pray for him. Also, please pray for his Dad. Brandon has applied to be able to work in the US. Right now, they have no source of income except for the GiveSendGo account. We pray the approval of his applications will be approved soon.

The work in South Africa is going well! Our latest church plant was begun in October 2021 by one of our college graduates, Munya Nyuke. Munya and his wife traveled with us in the USA on our last furlough. We hear almost weekly of souls saved! Praise the Lord.

We thank the Lord for Sipho and Matthews. Sipho oversees Bible Baptist Church of the Deaf in Johannesburg and the Zoom classes. Matthews is serving at Tshwane Deaf Baptist Church in Pretoria.

Lucinda and I have been visiting and preaching in many of our supporting churches and having meetings in new
