In Numbers 23:23, instead of cursing Israel, Balaam prophesied for Israel. He cried out in utter amazement, "What hath God wrought!" These past few months have brought the same question to my mind—What hath God wrought!

A few years ago, one of our missionaries visited our home office accompanied by a pastor from Hyderabad, India. We had a sweet time of fellowship. Last month this pastor asked me to teach Indian pastors through Zoom. I am old enough to still be amazed by modern technology. I never get over talking to missionaries overseas while I am driving my car! I did not need a passport or a plane ticket to participate in a conference 8,550 miles away. As I taught over 60 Indian pastors how to rightly divide the Word of God (2 Timothy 2:15), I felt like Alexander Graham Bell when he sent the first official Morse code message on May 24, 1844. He tapped, "What hath God wrought!"

Last month we held our annual BIO Training School. This is always a special week at BIO. Four new missionaries mingled with 16 veteran missionaries for a week of inspiration and instruction. Every session hit the theme (Our Strength is in the Lord), and the fellowship matched New Testament koinonia—What hath God wrought!

On July 29-30, the Lord gave me and a

couple of other BIO missionaries an exceptional ministry experience. We were invited to participate in a missions conference within a Florida prison. We had no idea what to expect.



After clearing security we walked into the heart of the prison where there was a chapel full of prisoners, many doing hard time. We mingled for a bit until the worship team began to sing. Nothing could have prepared me for 100+ prisoners exuberantly singing, "My chains are gone. I've been set free. My God, my Savior has ransomed me. And like a flood His mercy rains, unending love, amazing grace." After only a few minutes, I no longer saw prison scrubs and gang tattoos. I saw the matchless grace of God and thought, "What hath God wrought!"

We saw three saved and over twenty-five prisoners pledge to be preachers of the Gospel no matter where they may be taken. This prison church has pledged to give over \$1,600.00 to missions in the next year and now faithfully support three missionaries—two from BIO. What hath God wrought?
