Our ministry with boys has been going well and we've been able to see the Lord working in these young men's lives and them growing in their faithfulness to church and to God through this ministry.

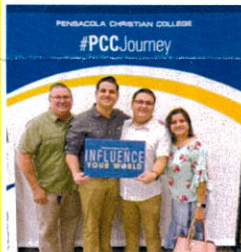

We trust that this letter finds you enjoying the blessings of God in your part of God's harvest field. As Field Director, I am writing this letter on behalf of the Doolittle Family, your missionaries to Brazil. This dear family has been faithful for 30 years on the field.

In the past few months, the Doolittles are remodeling the camp, which is also the property where they reside. Two years ago, we preached there to over 350 campers. We have witnessed firsthand how God has used that ministry to see souls saved and others called into the ministry. Peter's wife, Zirlene, trusted Christ there as a teenager, which is one reason why they are both committed to the ministry of Christian camp.

That being said, the Doolittles are having to invest heavily to totally wire the facilities on a solar system, which will drastically reduce their operating expenses. Their home church has stepped up to take care of the majority of this need. However, if each of their supporters were to help with a one-time offering of \$240, this need would be met. Perhaps your church has a special projects fund and would be interested in helping meet this need.
