Our church is growing and we've had many new people – especially kids – coming, praise the Lord! We are privileged to be able to invest in the next generation.

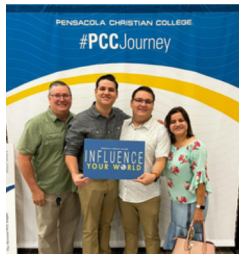


Our ministry with boys has been going well and we've been able to see the Lord working in these young men's lives and them growing in their faithfulness to church and to God through this ministry.

On September 7th we were able to celebrate Brazil's Independence Day. We had a teen day at camp with around 100 teenagers and several got saved!

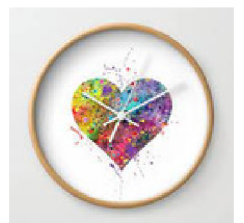


Kid's Camp
