Dear Family and Friends,

We cannot say thank you enough for your unending love, prayer, and support! This past April we were able to secure a building in Mongolia for the printing of God's Word. We are so thankful for all the behind-the-scenes work and workers. So much has gone into this Building of Hope and we are not taking your part in this lightly. Psalms 129:8 says, "The blessing of the LORD be upon you: we bless you in the name of the LORD."

As you may know from reading our last newsletter, we have a building in Mongolia that needs work before we can move the print shop to that location. We will be moving the print shop to that location as soon as we have the building renovated and usable for our printing ministry. We had hoped to return in mid-September with the needed money to complete this renovation, but, unfortunately, the money did not come in. We are still on the road raising the needed funds.

You may also know, while working on the print shop Building of Hope we are still at the old building and it is for sale. We were informed by the owner that as of November 1st there will be many changes made as to the way we are allowed to us this building. The changes make it almost impossible to continue working there. So we will be heading back to Mongolia on November 4th to begin packing and moving the print shop out of its current location. God has given us a great team to help us with this great task. We have purchased a forty foot container and it has been delivered to our old building. This will allow us to store many of our things in this container while we continue to work on the Building of Hope.

Because of the urgency to get back to Mongolia, we did not have money allocated for tickets and a container. These two expenses add up to \$10,000. Please pray with us about this need. Also please pray for us while we are in Mongolia. This will be without a doubt one of the busiest trip we have ever made. I Thessalonians 5:25 says exactly what we feel, "Brethren, pray for us." Above all that is said and done we need your prayers.

II Thessalonians 3:1 says, "Finally, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have free course, and be glorified, even as it is with you:" Pray for the salvation of the Mongolian people!
