As the New Year closed out 2022, and ushered itself in, some do not believe the pandemic to be over, and some have been over with the pandemic for over a year now. God blessed our ministry of Fires of Evangelism in 2022 with 19 conferences. Nearly 700 pastors, missionaries, and evangelists attended. Nearly 3000 salvation decisions were made, and almost 700 brethren surrendered their lives to serve our precious Lord full-time. As of right now, we have **28** conferences (which include a couple of youth conferences) on the calendar for 2023. Lord willing, this will also include going back to the Philippines in August. So, your constant prayers for provision, protection, and fullness of the promised Spirit are critically needed every week.

She told me that **no one** had ever told her how she could know for sure that she would go to heaven. I asked if I could be the first. She said yes!
