The Apostle John wrote in his third epistle: "We therefore ought to receive such [missionaries], that we might be fellowhelpers to the truth." (3 John 8) You are our fellowhelpers to the truth. Because of your faithfulness we could be fellowhelpers to our missionaries.

As fellowhelpers we've contacted many pastors and churches for missionaries. We've collected funds for missionaries and for their projects.

And this last week, as fellowhelpers, we've coordinated efforts to help evacuate a missionary family that was in

immediate danger and sought for the release of a spouse who has been abducted.

Last month, as fellowhelpers, we were able to help Joshua and Aimee Cortez (our kids) move to Ruskin, Florida. The Cortez family began their ministry with First Baptist Church in January. Please pray for them as they settle.



On February 21, BIO will hold its first *Missionary Table Talk*. These Table Talks are designed to be one-day, casual discussion for pastors, missionaries, and mission leaders. The goal is to help bridge the gap of misunderstanding between pastors and the real-life experience of missionaries.
