We have been in Honduras for just over a month, and God continues to bless us every day. **He has provided a place to live only 3 minutes from the church here, as well as reliable car to get us around.** Both of us have driven now, and it's quite the experience! We have been able to almost completely furnish our home and have just have a few more things left to get. Shopping for household items is a great cultural experience, and just today Amber was able to talk with two ladies in the store about the Bible while she was browsing for curtains.



We were also able to find Amber a doctor for her pregnancy, which is an answer to prayer. Another missionary wife who is also expecting took Amber along on one of her appointments to meet her doctor, and it looks like she will be a great fit for us too. Amber was able to get an ultrasound that same day and **we found out that God is blessing us with another daughter!** Sofia is very excited to meet her baby sister in just 16 more weeks (or less!).

I was able to find a Spanish tutor and I am starting on March 6th with those lessons to get me back to where I need to be. **Amber is meeting a potential tutor** on the 8th and we are optimistic that she will be able to start studies very soon as well. The missionary family we are working with here, the Goins, have been helpful in connecting us with people who can teach us, and we are thankful for that. Please pray specifically that the Lord would help us meet some language goals we have set for ourselves; I'd like to be finished with my studies or close to it by the end of June, and Amber is working towards finishing the halfway point in her studies before the baby arrives.

We had a wonderful, uplifting time at Vision Baptist Mission's Regional Conference in Colombia last week. All of our missionaries to Latin America got together and we were able to fellowship and be encouraged in our work for the Lord. We didn't purposely plan for our arrival in Honduras to fall one month before we would have to leave for a week for the regional conference, but it turned out to be the perfect encouragement for us the week before we shifted into full-time work and study.

Through every detail of our lives here, we see God's hand of love and guidance before us. Thank you for your prayers for us. We think of you often and are grateful to know that so many people are lifting us up before God's throne. May the Lord bless you as you serve Him!
