Missionaries to Mongolia

Our goal has been and still is to bring the Good News of Jesus to the thirsty country of Mongolia. Everything we are doing is to help bring the Word of God to this region of the world. Romans 10:17 says, "So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God." We want all Mongolians to have an opportunity to place their faith in the Lord Jesus Christ and secure their home in heaven!

We have several projects that need to be accomplished before we can reestablish the printing ministry in our new home and again print God's Word for the Mongolian people. Would you consider praying with us about these projects and pray for us as we return to Mongolia in the middle of May. As the time quickly approaches for our return, we have need of funds to complete several projects.



- ☐ **1. Water for the Building** Not only do we need water but the printing process uses water. As we are writing this newsletter we have a contract with a Mongolian company to drill us a well. Would you please pray that we can get water into our building.
- \$15,000**



- ☐ **2. Fence Repair** The fencing on two sides of our property is falling apart. We would like to replace it by a continuation of the concrete walls already on two sides of the property. This will give us much needed security.
- \$4,000**



- ☐ **3. New Bay Door** The current bay door is far from being secure and does very little to keep the cold out. It is important to be able to keep the printing equipment warm during the long winter months. We have already found a company that will install a Siberian garage door, that is designed to keep the extreme cold out.
- \$3,000**



- ☐ **4. Renovation** The first floor will be our print shop, digital press room, bindery and office but first we must remove all the saw dust and dirt that would hinder us from running our equipment. This is a priority to reestablish the printing ministry in Mongolia. Lots of elbow grease is needed for this project.
- \$5,000**



- ☐ **5. Completion of two apartments on the second floor of our building** These apartments are very much needed to help sustain the printing ministry. We rent these apartments out to help pay the utilities for the building as well to help pay the workers.
- \$8,000**

We are praying that we will be able to return to Mongolia with the money in hand to complete these projects. As of the writing of this newsletter we are about fifteen thousand dollars short of being able to finish these projects. Luke 14:28 gives us a warning, "For which of you, intending to build a tower, sitteth not down first, and counteth the cost, whether he have sufficient to finish it?" We need your help to finish these projects. Would you consider helping?

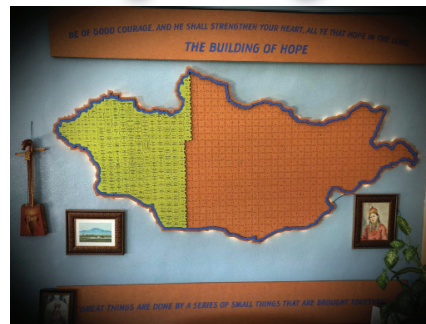
