In the month of March, I was blessed for four days to minister in the Tennessee Women's Therapeutic Facility. They allowed four of us to go back into the dorms to meet with these ladies. We took turns doing a bible study and giving them our testimonies. In the evening we had a preaching service with messages from one of our Rock of Ages' preachers. Three women asked the Lord to save them. On the last night we went to the chapel, but we were told that we could not have a service because a tornado was spotted in our area. We were advised not to leave until the weather improved. It was the only time I was not allowed to leave a prison.

During the month of April, I was able to teach a bible study in Silverdale, Tennessee. One lady called on the Lord for salvation. The last week of April was very busy. I went into a local jail, and I was privileged to teach in all three dorms. One lady received Christ as her Saviour. The last week of April I was blessed to go to a women's drug treatment center for a two-day meeting. We saw five women call on the Lord for salvation. In May we were allowed to go into a women's prison in Hawkinsville, Georgia – Pulaski Women's Prison. It has been three years since we were allowed to go into this prison. Thank you, Lord, for this special opportunity. You know sometimes we take it for granted the great ministry God has given us here in America, until it is taken away. They allowed us to go into the eight dorms and to give gospel literature and invite them to our service. Seven ladies professed Jesus Christ as their Lord and Saviour. The lady prisoners wanted to give me a brown jumpsuit to stay, but I declined. The Lord has blessed me SO much! We are the only contact with the outside that some of these ladies are exposed to and it burdens my heart for their souls. Please pray that God will allow me to continue to minister to these precious ladies and share with them the gospel of Jesus Christ, who is the only one who can save them and give them a new changed life. To God be the Glory!
