2023 Year-to-Date Fires

Since our last letter, we had conferences in Celaya, Mexico; Mutinlupa City, Philippines; Santa Ana, El Salvador, and Bogota, Colombia. God worked wonderfully in these conferences. I wish there was space here to share some testimonies of hearts touched in the Philippines. It was special. The hosting pastor has asked for me to come next year. Please pray for the funding to cover the airfare so that I can. Celaya had over 2300 in attendance, and there were hundreds of salvation decisions during the week. In these four conferences combined, we saw amazingly 142 brethren surrender their lives to serve God full-time. Between Celaya and the Philippines, 364 pastors, assistant pastors, evangelists, and missionaries attended. We are so blessed to have the ear of so many leaders and the opportunity to encourage and challenge them.

Last time I told you about Chris who I am training in witnessing in Spanish. Last month, we had the great blessing of witnessing to a lady from Honduras. Her name is Joseline. She has three children.
