During October, we worked to get our visas and our certification to get our belongings shipped to México duty-free. We had originally planned to do these things at the consulate in Indianapolis, but we were not able to hear back from them in a reasonable amount of time. Thankfully, we were able to go to New York City to have our visas and household goods certificate approved on October 23rd.

The Lord allowed things to work out for us to be part of our sending church's 50th anniversary celebration. We were able to ride the bus that Brittany and I once captained, and I was able to lead a young man named Jeremy to Christ. We were blessed tremendously to be part of such a great weekend before we left for the field!

We also praise the Lord that we were able to arrive in Mexico on October 25th! Our flights went smoothly and none of our luggage was lost. We are currently working out the logistics of getting the rest of our belongings across the border and to us here in central México. We are also working on getting our residency cards. Additionally, we are finishing getting our house set up, getting Mexican cell phones, and purchasing a vehicle. We covet your prayers in all of these matters.

During this short time in Irapuato, México, I have already had the privilege of leading two men to the Lord. Please pray that Natividad and Antonio would grow as Christians and would attend church faithfully. We are very thankful for the opportunities Pastor Arrache has given us to be involved in ministry here. Please pray that God would help us to get settled in and that He would use us mightily for His ministry here in México.
