

Dear Co-Laborers,

Greetings once again from the Dan Brooks Family in Bolivia.

In our last letter I mentioned the baptism of our granddaughter Zoe on August 20th. This October 29th our grandson Solomon was also baptized, It brings great joy to our hearts when our children and grandchildren follow our Lord and grow not only physically but even more importantly spiritually. We are praying for our youngest grandchildren, Boaz and Chloe, that they will also grow to love the Lord . We live in such complicated times where the enemy is working overtime to destroy the next



generation.

Recently Ali Osinaga, the husband of Ana Maria Padilla, who is one of the most faithful believers of the Tierras Nuevas Baptist Church, had an accident where he was burned quite severely. The Lord has used this experience to bring Ali to the Lord after many years of alcoholism and



an abusive marriage.

Ali has started coming to church regularly along with his wife and many of the members of this large family. Please pray for Ali and Ana Maria. We have mentioned Sister Joaquina Figueroa who is Ana Maria's mother, although up in years never misses a church meeting and also accompanies us to visit the rural church in the Olives. We were able to implant a pacemaker in

Sister Joaquina Figueroa twice and now she is on her third pacemaker. But because of the politics in Bolivia our Pacemaker bank is sadly still waiting for government approval to resume this ministry of implanting pacemakers in poor people who have no health insurance or financial means of living a long normal life with the help of a free pacemaker.

We continue to fellowship with the group of German believers in the locality of San Luis, also I have been able to share the gospel with several mennonites that are very open to the gospel. We are setting up several dates to go out to their colonies and meet in their homes. Pray with us that their eyes would be opened and the Light of our Lord Jesus would shine on them that they may be brought out of spiritual darkness.

In the Mount Olives Baptist Church, sister Nicanora Galarza is the most faithful believer since the church was founded back in 1989. Nicanora calls us almost everyday to let us know how each of the believers is doing! She has Chagas (a rare heart condition) and needs a pacemaker quite soon. Her heart rate is down to 40 beats per minute and she could have an electrical heart block if she does not get a pacemaker. The cost of a dual chamber pacemaker along with the implant procedure is \$5000 here in Bolivia. Please pray with us concerning this need for our dear



sister.

Thank you once again for praying and giving for the lost souls of Bolivia.
