While I was gone, Nicole successfully figured and formulated the 1099s for all of our missionaries. Thank you for your prayers for us during this full month and for your partnership with us.

Amber Yingling met me at the airport. It had been almost two years since we had seen each other in person. What a joy to be reunited! I was thrilled to see how much she had grown as an individual and as a missionary. Glory to God for His work! The Lord enabled us to minister together for three weeks in the Philippines on three different islands. We broke this up into four phases.

PAMPANGA

The day after I landed we traveled three hours by car to the province of Pampanga. That night we were able to visit



the orphanage where Amber will be doing an internship for a year. The next day I spoke for a youth event at Subic Bay Baptist Church. Then, on Saturday and Sunday, I preached a revival for our missionaries, Nap and Shirley Donado at Beulah Land Baptist Church. We praise the Lord for the four that were saved in Pampanga and the many other decisions that were made. Glory to God for His work!

MINDANAO

After one day of leisure and laundry we headed back to the airport in Manila to fly to the Island of Mindanao. BIO



Missionaries Kevin and JoAnn Trout met us at the airport in Ozamiz City. We spent three days encouraging the Trouts and spoiling the kids in their children's home. On Wednesday I preached at the mission on their property. One of the Trout's workers listened intently to the Gospel message. Please pray for Amy to be saved. Glory to God for His work!

NEGROS

We flew back to Manila in order to catch a flight to the Island of



Negros. Here we met with over thirty pastors and their wives for a BIO Philippines conference. I preached on Friday night and Saturday, and then on Sunday I preached at the Bayawan City First Baptist Church. Many were encouraged in the Lord, and two made sure of their salvation. While on this island we were also able to travel to seven other churches in Negros Occidental and Negros Oriental. As a missionary, I have never been more excited about an indigenous church planting movement as I was on the Island of Negros. Glory to God for His work!

BATANGAS

We flew back to Manila on Monday to spend our last week together in Batangas with Rusty



and Lita Ocampo at Heavenly Bible Baptist Church. This is were Amber is currently serving. On Tuesday, I preached to over 500 that included 75 pastors at a Prayer and Fasting fellowship hosted by the church. On Wednesday night I spoke again, and four members declared their desire to be missionaries. On Saturday I spoke at a special children's event to 250 children, and on Sunday I preached both services. Nine came forward for salvation on Sunday morning, and on Sunday evening I was blessed to pray a prayer of dedication over more than 30 Bible students. Glory to God for His work!
